Obtain a Business License

A business license is required by any person conducting business in Peoria (including home businesses). Learn about the business license approval process. Business License applications may take up to 30 days for approval. Applications are reviewed by several departments which may require additional permits.

Obtain a Transaction Privilege Tax (TPT) License

Businesses subject to the Transaction Privilege (Sales) Tax need a Transaction Privilege (TPT) License with the Arizona Department of Revenue.

Sell Items that are Flammable/Combustible

An operational permit is required for businesses that include fireworks, combustible or hazardous materials, repair garages, or paint booths.

Offer Alcohol for Sale/Consumption

Establishments selling alcohol for onsite or offsite consumption require a liquor license with the Arizona Department of Liquor Licenses and Control. Information may be found at https://azliquor.gov.
