


Vistancia Technology Park is a headquarters-class location with planned amenities necessary to support a wide variety of company needs. Almost a **million people are within a 30-minute drive**, making it an accessible location that can attract workers from across Greater Phoenix. This number will grow quickly as tech companies begin choosing the area for their new operations in the coming years. **Phoenix Sky Harbor International Airport** is within a 45 minute drive via the Loop 303 to Interstate 17.

The Vistancia Technology Park has **all infrastructure in place and ready for development**. The city has made improvements to our water distribution system to meet the demands of tech-focused companies, including foundries and similar fab manufacturers. Zona Communications is the prime telecommunications provider in the area and has a fiber optic loop system in place that will serve Vistancia Technology Park with the necessary bandwidth capacity needed for companies.

SEMICONDUCTOR SUCCESS

Vistancia Technology Park is the perfect site for semiconductor suppliers and the smart manufacturing industry. As TSMC begins to build out their campus a few miles east of Vistancia, suppliers can find ready to build sites and be ready for the construction of their main facility. Companies will find a strong labor force already in the area, with many working at Honeywell Aerospace, Texas Instruments, L-3 Communications, and other tech suppliers.

The Greater Phoenix region is the 8th largest metro area for electronics employment, with **more than 16,000 workers in semiconductor and related device manufacturing**. Employers will find a competitive wage environment for electrical engineers, machinists, and other specialized skill sets. This financial advantage is ideal for globally-focused companies that need skilled and affordable labor. Combined with a favorable tax structure, Peoria is a costeffective business location.





Vistancia Technology Park has the space to be designed or planned in creative ways to meet a client's vision and needs. Class A office buildings, research and development labs, or light industrial for smart manufacturing, Vistancia Technology Park is ready for it all.









Peoria has a close working relationship with Arizona State University for workforce development. The Vistancia area in Peoria is one of the fastest growing areas in the country with


